This Notice of Guaranteed Delivery is being provided in connection with the offer by XPLR INFRASTRUCTURE OPERATING PARTNERS, LP (the “Offeror”), to purchase for cash any and all of its outstanding 3.875% Senior Notes due 2026 (CUSIP Nos. 65342Q AL6 (144A) / U6500T AG0 (Reg. S)) (ISINs US65342QAL68 (144A) / USU6500TAG05 (Reg. S)) (the “Notes”), from holders thereof (each, a “Holder” and collectively, the “Holders”) upon the terms and subject to the conditions set forth in this Notice of Guaranteed Delivery, the Offer to Purchase dated November 12, 2025 (as it may be amended or supplemented from time to time, the “Statement”) and in the Letter of Transmittal (as it may be amended or supplemented from time to time, the “Letter of Transmittal,” together with this Notice of Guaranteed Delivery and the Statement, the “Offer”). As of November 11, 2025, \$500,000,000 aggregate principal amount of Notes were outstanding.

As set forth in the Statement, this form or one substantially equivalent hereto must be used to accept the Offer if you cannot deliver your Notes and all other required documents to the Tender Agent, or if your Notes are not immediately available, by the Expiration Time, or the procedure for book-entry transfer cannot be completed on a timely basis, you may tender your Notes pursuant to the guaranteed delivery procedure described in the Statement by or through any eligible institution. All authority conferred or agreed to be conferred by this Notice of Guaranteed Delivery shall not be affected by, and shall survive, the death or incapacity of the undersigned, and every obligation of the undersigned under this Notice of Guaranteed Delivery shall be binding upon the heirs, executors, administrators, trustees in bankruptcy, personal and legal representatives, successors and assigns of the undersigned.

The Notes may be submitted only in principal amounts equal to minimum denominations of \$2,000 and integral multiples of \$1,000 in excess thereof.

If the ATOP procedures are used, the DTC participant need not complete and physically deliver the Notice of Guaranteed Delivery. However, the DTC participant will be bound by the terms of the Offer.

As more fully described in the Offer, the Notes, or confirmation of book-entry transfer of the Notes, and all other required documents, will be required to be provided no later than 5:00 p.m., New York City time, November 20, 2025, which is two business days following the Expiration Time.
